









How to get to BCN Amsterdam Arena

BCN Amsterdam Arena

PUBLIC TRANSPORT:

BCN Amsterdam Arena is within walking distance of Amsterdam Bijlmer Arena Station.



BY FOOT:

Exit the station and turn left towards the bus station. Walk parallel to the railway, and then take the first right into Hoogoorddreef.

The Atlas Arena Complex is on the opposite side of the street. The Asia Building is behind on the access road.



PRIVATE TRANSPORT:

Coming from The Hague / Zaandam / Alkmaar: Take the A10, then take the A2 towards Utrecht. Take the Ouderkerk a/d Amstel / Duivendrecht exit (exit 1). Then follow the route described under 'Exit 1 Ouderkerk a/d Amstel / Duivendrecht'.

From Utrecht / Den Bosch:

Follow the A2 towards Amsterdam. Take the Ouderkerk a/d Amstel / Duivendrecht exit (exit 1).

Then follow the route described under 'Exit 1 Ouderkerk

Then follow the route described under 'Exit 1 Ouderkerk a/d Amstel / Duivendrecht'.

From Amersfoort:

Follow A1 until you pass Muiden. Then follow the signs to Amstelveen (A9). Take exit S111 ('Zuid-Oost / AMC'). Turn right at the traffic lights at the end of the exit lane. Follow this road until you can turn right (follow the signs to Arena car park / Ikea). Follow this road as it curves to the left (Hondsrugweg). Then, almost at the end of this road, take the third right (just before the second traffic light). You are now in the Atlas Arena Complex.

BCN Amsterdam Arena is in the Asia Building on the 5th floor

BCN has two venues in Amsterdam:
BCN Amsterdam Arena and BCN Amsterdam.
Please double check the venue at which your meeting is being held.

Exit 1 Ouderkerk a/d Amstel / Duivendrecht:

Take the Ouderkerk a/d Amstel / Duivendrecht exit (exit 1). At the traffic lights at the top of the exit, turn left towards Duivendrecht (Burg. Stramanweg). Follow this road for about 100 m, keeping to the right ('Zuid-Oost / AMC / Duivendrecht') until the traffic lights in front of the Villa Arena residential and shopping complex. Turn right here. Go straight on at the next two traffic lights, then turn left at the third traffic light into Hoogoorddreef. Go straight on at the next two traffic lights. After about 50 m, turn right. You are now in the Atlas Arena Complex.

BCN Amsterdam Arena is on the 5th floor of the Asia Building.



PARKING

The complex has its own public car park, Antarctica (P9).

You can pay for your parking in P9 by debit card at the reception of BCN at a discounted rate.

Antarctica car park (P9) is opposite BCN Amsterdam Arena. We do not have exit tickets for car park P10.

Alternatives are ArenA Transferium park-and-ride and the P10 car park which is within walking distance from BCN Amsterdam Arena.

BY FOOT FROM P9 TO BCN AMSTERDAM ARENA

The complex has its own public car park, Antarctica (P9).

Antarctica car park (P9) is located opposite BCN Amsterdam Arena.

BCN Amsterdam Arena is on the 5th floor of the Asia Building.

BY FOOT TO BCN AMSTERDAM ARENA FROM P10 PLAZA ARENA

When you leave P10 Plaza Arena, you will find yourself in Hondsrugweg.

Cross this road diagonally to the left, then enter the Atlas Arena Complex. Follow this road and pass under a building.

The entrance to the Asia Building will be on your right.

PRIVATE TRANSPORT:

Transferium Amsterdam ArenA is located on the A2 motorway. There are road signs on the motorways around Amsterdam to direct you and also indicate whether Arena park-and-ride is open.

Rates

The park-and-ride fee depends on the time when you enter:

- Before 10:00 (Mon to Fri): first 24 hours € 8,00, then € 1,00 per 24 hours AM
- After 10:00 (Mon to Fri): € 1,00 per 24 hours AM
- Saturday and Sunday: € 1,00 per 24 hours AM

You can park at Arena park-and-ride for up to 96 hours. If you are not using the park-and-ride facility, the fee is € 1,00 per 25 minutes, max. € 24,50 per day.

You can pay with debit card or credit card (MasterCard / Maestro).



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

A GVB park-and-ride ticket for 2 people to the city centre costs \leq 5,00. For each additional passenger up to a max. of 5 passengers per car, there is a charge of \leq 0,90.

Underground lines 50 and 54.

A number of trains provide services between Amsterdam Central and Bijlmer Arena.

Destination: Bijlmer Arena

If you take the bus or tram from Amsterdam Arena park-and-ride, get off at Bijlmer Arena.



BY FOOT

Exit the station and turn left towards the bus station. Walk parallel to the railway and then take the first right into Hoogoorddreef.

The Atlas Arena Complex is on the opposite side of the street. The Asia Building is behind on the access road.
