Engage and Exchange


- Collaborative learning

Organizing Your Session: Formula for Success

Take 5-10 minutes to frame your session. What is the group going to do over the next 45-60 minutes?



Plan for 30-35 minutes of dedicated small group discussion (breakout groups)



Use the last 20 minutes for sharing and open discussion.



Engage and Exchange Notes

- Max audience size = 50 people in the interactive space and ~25 in the observation area
- Handouts are highly encouraged. **The deadline for submitting handouts to DIA is May 7.**
- E&Es will take place in a dynamic workspace within the Exhibit Hall
- Facilitators will be responsible for encouraging participants to recall and analyze information, share their personal experiences, draw conclusions, and/or practice new skills. **The focus of an E&E session is to have the attendees work together, and the role of the presenter(s) is to facilitate these discussions with less emphasis on a didactic presentation.**
