

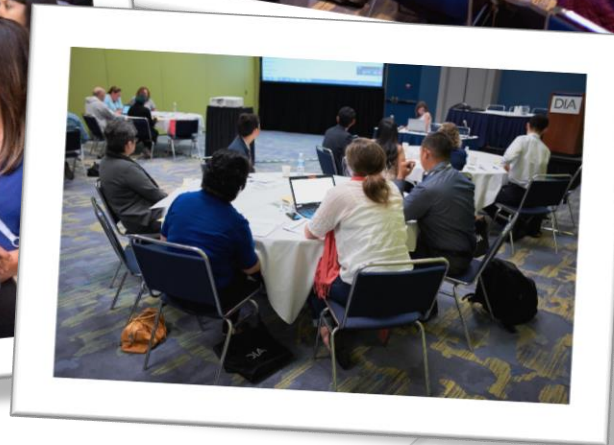

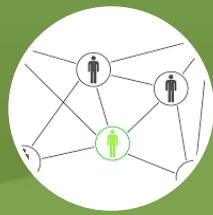

A Guide to Presenting
Your Polling Questions



I Have My Interactive Question Slide(s): Now What?



Step 1

Identify your polling question(s) by the looking at the notes section of your slide(s).



Step 2

Copy and paste the slide(s) into your slide deck where you want them to appear in your presentation.



Step 3

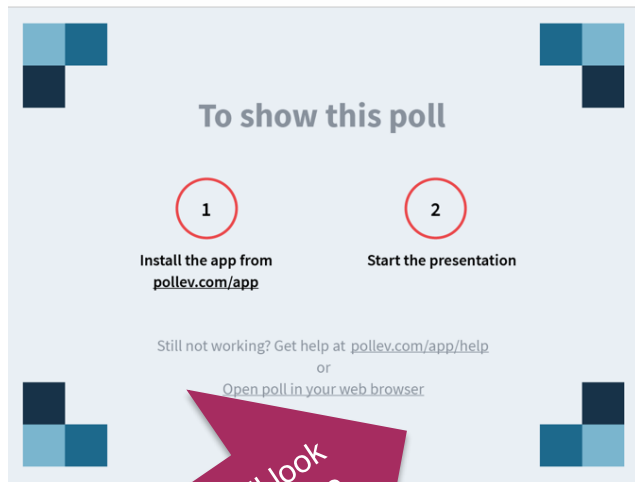
Submit your final slide deck to DIA on June 14. Slides must be submitted using PowerPoint.

DO NOT delete the notes on your interactive slide(s). The interactive questions will not appear if the notes are deleted.

Something Went Wrong: These Can't Be My Slides



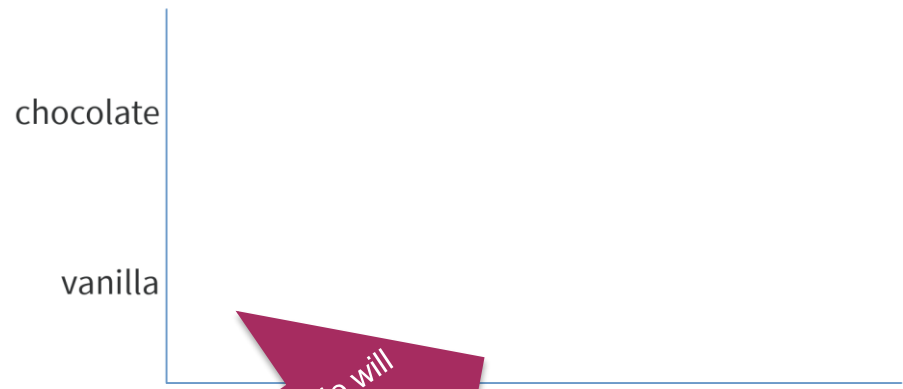
Nothing is wrong! These are your correct polling slides. DIA's AV technicians will activate your polling slide(s) immediately prior to your presentation so that they show the question and response to the audience during your live presentation.



All polling slides will look like this prior to your live presentation



When poll is active, respond at PollEv.com/am2018 or Text **AM2018** to **22333** once to join



This is what your slide will look like during your presentation... with your question of course!

I'm Still Nervous... Can I Test Polling Prior to My Presentation?



You will **not** be able to activate your slides prior to your presentation or in the Speaker Ready Room. Playing your slide deck in slide show view within PowerPoint will not activate the polling slides. This is normal and not an indication that your polling slides will not function properly during your presentation.

Introducing Your Interactive Questions to the Audience


Before your first interactive question, tell the audience that you will be asking them to participate using their mobile devices or laptops.


Now I'm going to ask for your opinion. Please open your laptop, tablet, or cell phone, but remember to leave them on silent.

You will be able to participate by sending a text message or visiting a web address on your laptop, phone, or tablet.

Explaining Participation Through Texting

- To participate you must first join my session. Do this by sending a message to the five digit number shown on the interactive question slide.

- 
- In the body of the message, you'll type the keyword that appears on the interactive question slide.

- From there, just reply to that message with your response.

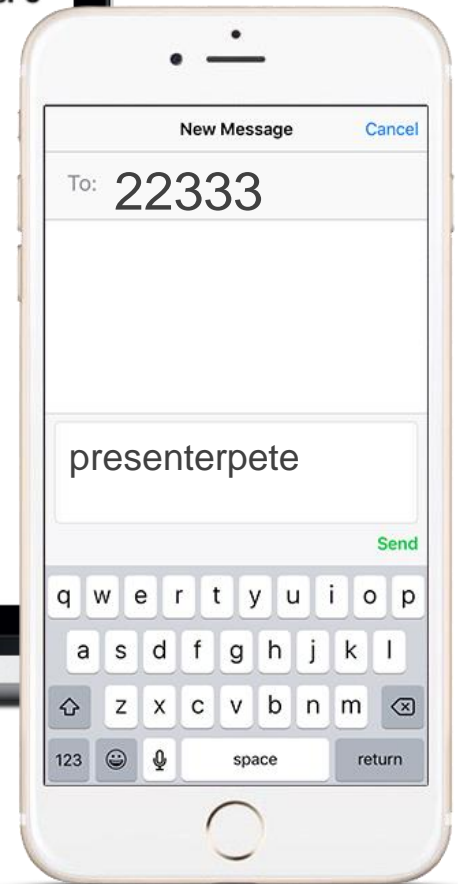

Addressing Audience Concerns
