Short Courses, Monday, June 21 through Friday, June 25, 2021

Continuing Education

- Select short courses offer AMA PRA Category 1 Credit(s)TM, (physician CME credit), pharmacy or nursing contact hours, or Project Management Institute (PMI) professional development units (PDUs); all short courses offer IACET continuing education units (CEUs). There are 16 short courses.

Documenting Attendance

- Participants must login to view the live short course offering in order to record attendance. Participants who do not login to view the live short course offering will not be eligible to request the available CE credits for that short course. Continuing Education (CE)

IACET continuing education units (CEUs) are offered for most program offerings. CE credits are **NOT AVAILABLE** for, Content Hubs, Innovation Theater, Community Rounds, Professional Development, Solution Circles, Spotlight Symposia, Lunch and Learns, Networking Sessions, or Posters.

To Request CE for DIA 2021 Sessions:

- CE credit requests and attendance certificates are accessed through My Transcript
- My Transcript opens on **Wednesday, July 7, 2021**
- In order for participants to obtain credit/attendance certificate, they must:
 - Click on “**Check into Session**” button, located under the session video, this will also enable the chat. Failure to click on “Check into Session” button will not capture your attendance and you will not be allowed to claim CE credit.
 - Log onto DIA’s My Transcript beginning Wednesday, July 7, 2021 to request available CE (See below My Transcript flyer for complete step by step instructions)
- **ACPE credit requests must be submitted by Friday, August 6, 2021**, in order for the credit request to be transmitted to the CPE Monitor; any questions regarding ACPE credit or the CPE Monitor, contact Pauline.Sylvester@diaglobal.org
- DIA does not offer continuing legal education credits. Attorneys must contact their state board directly for claiming CLE credit for their participation in this event. Access MY Transcript to obtain transcripts.

Documenting Attendance

- DIA is working with MeetingPlay to capture attendance electronically during the live program offerings
