



## Health and Well-being

The COVID-19 pandemic is constantly changing, but DIA's commitment to the health and safety of our constituents remains consistent. Because of DIA's unwavering commitment to protecting and preserving public health we have made the decision that all participants at in-person DIA Meetings, Workshops, Forums and Conferences, whether a presenter, attendee, exhibitor, staff, guest, or vendor, **are required to be fully vaccinated**.

This decision was reached by examining public health and safety guidance, meeting spaces, our own event requirements, and the fact that conditions continue to change. It is our top priority to create the safest possible environment, and we will do this by proceeding with the current best practices and information available to us.

Our in-person meetings will also have a virtual component. You have the option of registering for one of the following: the in-person event or for access to the Live Virtual Event. We recognize and respect that all who choose to participate will make the best decision for themselves and will be responsible for their own choices.

If you are unable to be vaccinated due to medical condition, disability, or a sincerely held religious belief, please register for the Live Virtual Event.

We are continuing to review and evaluate the outlook for in-person events and will provide updates as they become available. As we get closer to our events, we will post more information about what you can expect onsite.

Upon registering for the in-person meeting, you will receive a link to upload and verify your vaccine status. We do have a cap on registration numbers to ensure air flow, space and seating are conducive to providing a safe and healthy event.

## Mask Requirement

For meetings in January through June 2022, DIA will require and enforce that all individuals must wear a mask indoors unless you are active eating, drinking or presenting in a session.
