

Enrollment:

How do I enroll in a Certificate Program?

Enrollment is free! Simply visit the DIA website at www.DIAglobal.org/certificateprograms and select the Certificate Program of interest. Once enrolled, you will be able to track your progress through My Certificate Programs area of the DIA website. Any courses you take that count towards the program will automatically be applied to your certificate program.

Who is permitted to enroll in the program? Do I need to be a DIA member?

The Certificate Program is open to anyone. Although you do not need to be a DIA member, members receive a discounted registration fee. You can become a member by visiting the DIA website and clicking “Become a Member” on the top of the page.

What does it cost to complete a Certificate Program?

Enrollment in the Certificate Program is free. Registration fees apply to the specific courses for which you would like to complete. The fees vary by course and you should view specific course details by accessing the DIA Website at: <http://www.DIAglobal.org/en/in-person>

Curriculum:

What is the value of a DIA Certificate Program and how will it help me in my career?

DIA’s Certificate Programs incorporate training courses and other educational events that help build the skills and knowledge needed in your profession. It demonstrates your commitment to continued professional development.

When does the Certificate Program start? How often are courses available?

You can enroll in the Certificate Program at any time. DIA events are offered throughout the year.

What are the requirements to complete a Certificate Program?

Each Certificate Program has minimum core and elective course requirements.

Certificate Program	Minimum Core Requirements	Minimum Elective Requirements
Clinical Research (CRCP)	35 CRCP Core Units	6 CRCP Elective Units
Clinical Safety and Pharmacovigilance (CSPCP)	16 CSPCP Core Units	16 CSPCP Elective Units
Project Management (PMCP)	48 PMCP Core units	8 PMCP Elective units
Regulatory Affairs (RCP)	28 RCP Core Units	16 RCP Elective Units

What delivery methods are available to Certificate Program enrollees?

We offer a variety of learning platforms: Face to face and online training courses, eLearning, Meetings, Webinars and DIA’s annual meeting.

How long does it take to complete a Certificate Program?

The completion time will depend on your availability and ability to register for upcoming events. Most people finish the program in about two years. One of the benefits of the certificate program is the ability to customize your experience to your own timeline.

How do I track my completed units?

Certificate program units are tracked in My Certificate Programs, located in your DIA account.

Is this a Certificate Program or a certification? What will I receive upon completion of the program?

DIA’s program is a certificate program. You will receive a certificate of completion that states that you have completed the necessary program requirements. You do not need to take any tests to get your certificate.
