

Marketing Free Zone

Due to comments from our exhibitors and attendees, exhibiting companies will be restricted from marketing activities unapproved by DIA in the immediate vicinity of McCormick Place and the Hyatt Regency at McCormick Place. This includes, but is not limited to, Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard, Indiana Avenue, Lake Shore Drive, and McCormick Place Square.

All marketing activities must be pre-approved in writing by DIA.

Companies found in violation of this policy will be required to immediately cease the unapproved activity, remove any unapproved advertising materials, and will receive a reduction in Exhibit Space Assignment Order Points for DIA 2019 in San Diego, CA and DIA 2020 in Boston, MA.


Marketing activities that will not be allowed in this zone include, but are not limited to:
