

How is content developed for DIA 2019?

In an effort to continue to evolve DIA's Global Annual Meeting, we are inviting you to participate in our development process for <u>DIA 2019</u>. Brainstorming together, we aim to gain a better understanding of your professional needs and the type of content we should focus on for the 2019 program agenda.

What is does it mean to "submit a topic"?

What do you want to learn more about? Help us understand your educational and professional needs, and let us know what topics you want us to explore at DIA 2019. This is your opportunity to share your suggestions on thought-provoking, trending, and timely topics that are important to you, your colleagues, and the DIA community. Submission of a topic is not in any way related to a speaking or Session Chair role at DIA 2019. An open Call for Abstracts will be available in August of 2018 to solicit sessions and presentations for DIA 2019. To submit a topic, please click here.

How do I submit a Topic?

To submit a topic, simply <u>fill out this form</u>, describe your topic in 250 characters or less, and let us know which of our 12 tracks this topic belongs to. Topic submissions are due July 6, 11:59PM ET.

What will these topics be used for?

Topic suggestions will be reviewed by the Annual Meeting Program Committee to assist with the content development and strategy for DIA 2019. Please note that submission of a topic is not in any way related to a speaking or Session Chair role at DIA 2019.

How can I speak at DIA 2019?

A Call for Abstracts will be available in August of 2018 to solicit session content and presentations for DIA 2019.

How do I submit my topic?

The topic should be submitted via this form, not directly to DIA.

Are there extensions to the July 6 deadline?

No, there will be no extensions.

May I submit more than one topic?

Yes, you may submit more than one topic, and we encourage you to submit multiple ones. However, the same topic should not be submitted to more than one track.

Are there any fees associated with submitting a topic?

No, there are no fees.

Do I have to be a member of DIA to submit a topic?

No, membership is not a requirement.

Do I have to identify potential speakers for my topic?

No, this is not required.

What if my topic does not fit into one of the identified tracks?

You are encouraged to submit a proposed topic, whether or not if it fits neatly into one of the twelve tracks, but it is still a requirement to select a track to submit a topic to. Select the track that is the most aligned with your topic.

If my topic is selected, will I be developing a session for that topic?

Topics will neither be accepted nor rejected. Instead, these topics will be used to help DIA and the Annual Meeting Program Committee understand what content you are looking for at the meeting.

Why should I submit a topic if I am not guaranteed a speaking opportunity?

This is your opportunity to help shape the content for DIA 2019, and a chance for DIA to gain a better understanding of your needs.

Will I be notified if my topic is selected?

No. These topics are merely meant to inform DIA of your educational needs, so there is no formal acceptance and therefore, no notification will be sent.
